**ORDER REGARDING JUDGE BAKER'S JANUARY 5, 2021 CIVIL CALENDAR  
AND NOTICE OF REMOTE CIVIL NON-JURY PROCEEDINGS**

In accordance with the Orders Declaring a Statewide Judicial Emergency issued by Chief Justice Harold Melton, Georgia Supreme Court, which has been extended nine times, and the Coweta Circuit Order issued by Chief Judge John Simpson; and,

In the considering the recommendations of the Georgia Supreme Court recognizing the continuing and dangerous spread of COVID-19 in Georgia with the recent acceleration of cases; and; In order to protect the public and court personnel while continuing to allow access to essential judicial functions;

**THIS COURT HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

The published January Superior Court calendar for Judge Baker remains unchanged. All court sessions shall be virtual. The link to the court session shall be sent out prior to the hearing date; HOWEVER, Judge Baker will conduct court from the courtroom and the courtroom itself shall remain open.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:**

Pursuant to the Supreme Court's temporary order entered March 27, 2020 regarding the Superior Court Rules, as well as Uniform Superior Court Rule 9.2, this Court's civil non-jury calendar scheduled for January 5, 2021, SHALL be conducted remotely. To the extent allowed by Rule 9.2 as amended, said cases may be conducted using ZOOM teleconferencing.

Any party who objects to their case appearing before the Court via teleconference should notify the Judge's office. To the extent that there are any teleconference hearings, any member
