
EMERGENCY SCHEDULING ORDER FOR MARCH 19, 20, and 23, 2020

On Thursday March 19, 2020, defense attorneys and prosecutors will report to the Carroll County Courthouse at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom C. We will have technology available to allow the Court to do bond hearings by video conference with the jail. In the video hearing, the Defendant will be on video from the jail, and the defense attorney and prosecutor will be at the Courthouse. Defendants who are out on bond shall not appear at the Courthouse on Thursday but will be rescheduled for a later date. Please make all efforts to minimize the number of people who come to the Courthouse on Thursday.

Thursday's calendar will emphasize bonds and reducing the jail population. The defense attorneys and prosecutors are to work from now until Thursday morning on negotiating probation agreements and consent bonds. On Thursday the Court asks that the calendar be handled expeditiously, and the Court will not be putting cases or discussions on hold.

The Court will hear inmate pleas on March 23, 2020. Attorneys will sign pleas up on Monday morning starting at 8:30 a.m. The signed-up pleas will be heard Monday afternoon, starting at 1:00 p.m. The plea must be in writing and given to the Clerk by 5:00 p.m. Friday, March 20, 2020 in order to be heard on the Monday plea date.
